- As part of the assessment ongoing within the program, we can conclude that a go-live of mFRR EAM ("automated operation") won't be possible as planned in November 2022 but will be postponed.

Fallback for electronic ordering

- We have previously asked if FiftyWeb can be used as a back-up for electronic ordering
- There was a clear indication that this is difficult for BSPs due to:
 - Need for manual handling - which is not acceptable for a long time
 - Insufficient support in FiftyWeb
- Follow-up questions:
 - Could this solution work for a limited time period such as up to a X hours?
 - If yes: What is the time limit?
 - What kind of support would be required in FiftyWeb for this to work?
